Building owners and employers have a responsibility to ensure occupants/ employees are trained on how to respond to a fire emergency.

Instructions to occupants must be prominently posted throughout your building to ensure a timely and effective evacuation. Fire wardens should be easily identifiable with vests or hats to help occupants and fire department personnel communicate concerns and instructions effectively.
